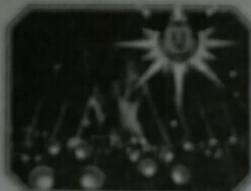


## Letters to the Editor

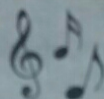

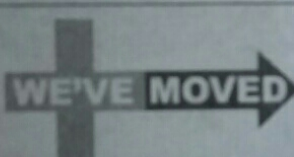

### Entomologists Magnify Bizarre Bug Colony

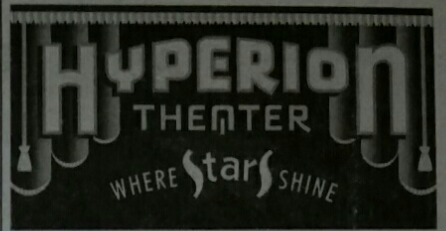

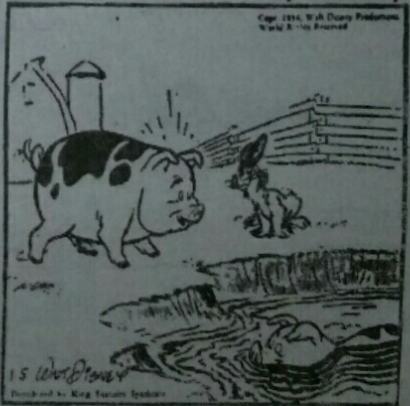

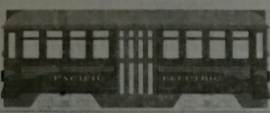
